Status update

Long Term Ash Storage Area Program

- Carting of top soil to the Ash Storage Area continues.
- Seven trucks, four D6 dozers, one 30t excavator, one PistenBully and one 45t excavator are working at the site.
- Dust monitors remain in operation to provide real-time data for monitoring and reporting.



Ash Storage Area Revegetation

- Native vegetation seeding on the top soil completed on 3 of the 5 top soiled zones last week

Polishing Pond

- Water in the polishing pond has increased following the recent rains. Flinders Power personnel continue to monitor and manage the pond for odour.
